Over the past year intensive work has been done by the Center for Environmental Information to understand potential sources of phosphorus in Oak Orchard Creek that have led to impaired water quality the Upper watershed. The results of this investigation will be presented along with the results of a computer model that has been developed to mimic the stream's water quality. Preliminary options for the most cost effective watershed changes to restore water quality will also be presented. Ample opportunity will be provided for input from all interested stakeholders.
